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ABOUT FAIRVIEW

Fairview Polwarths is located on loamy undulating country 14km south-east of Colac where the average annual rainfall is 900mm.

Greg, Kaye and Sam Potter run 750 Polwarth ewes in a self-replacing stud and commercial wool/prime lamb operation. Approximately 350 ewes are selected for the stud based on conformation traits and wool quality.

These ewes are mated to Polwarth rams while the remaining ewes are joined to White Suffolk rams.

Ewes lamb in June with lambs weaned at approximately 14-16 weeks. Depending on the season crossbred lambs are sold early December with the balance sold early March. The flock is shorn late December/early January.



HISTORY

There is a long tradition of Polwarth sheep on Fairview dating back to the 1930's. When Greg took over the family property in 1993, there were 130 ewes and 100 wethers. Greg set about improving the flock and learning about the Polwarth breed. Early rams were purchased from Sazli (flock number 256, VIC). Several years later when the Sazli stud dispersed, Greg purchased the remaining ewes and rams and subsequently registered a new flock (number 700) with the Polwarth Sheep Breeders' Association of Australia in 2000.

From 2003-2009 rams purchased from the successful Mt Alma (flock number 294, SA) stud injected size and improved the frame of ewes who are now robust and upstanding. Between 2011 and 2016, the use of Homeleigh (flock number 213, Heathcote, VIC) rams increased wool quality and density in the flock. A line of Coree (flock number 165, NSW) ewes purchased in 2013 and Homeleigh ewes purchased in 2016 have added further breadth and depth to the genetics of the flock.

In January 2019, Fairview Polwarths purchased the Rendlesham stud (registered flock number 523) from Tasmania. The stud has continued in its own right as Rendlesham at Fairview (registered flock number 709). A further 300 Rendlesham ewe lambs were purchased in January 2020.

PERFORMANCE RECORDING

To work towards our objectives efficiently, animals are individually recorded on Sapien Technology Kool Collect software where the following information is recorded:

- Electronic identification
- Pedigree
- Health treatments
- Weight gain
- Wool & Carcase Measurements
- Breeding Performance

OUR FOCUS

Living in a 900mm rainfall area where average temperatures are cooler (between 10-20 degrees) and cloud cover predominates our focus includes feet, fleece and maternal traits of mothering and milking ability.

Feet - we continually aim for good hoof structure which stand up to the persistent soggy muddy conditions on the property.

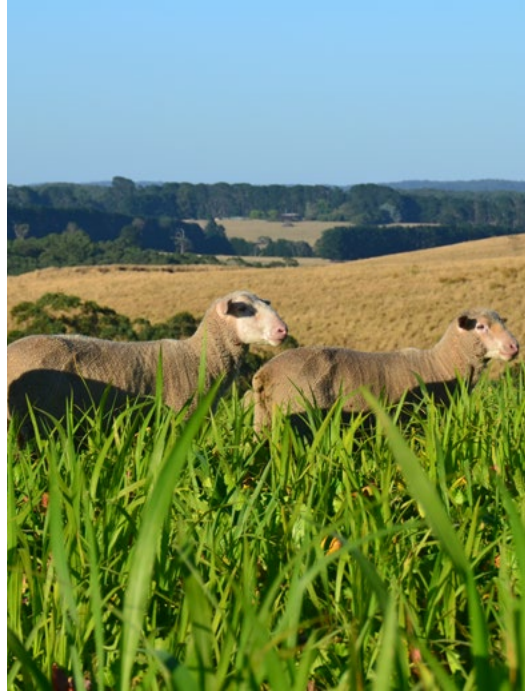
Fleece - we aim for white, well-nourished wool which has good staple structure. For commercial reasons we have slowly decreased the average micron of the flock which is currently sitting at 21.6 micron.

Maternal Traits - maternal traits of strong mothering and milking ability are vital for lambs to survive and thrive in our environment. To monitor these traits, lambs are tagged and weighed at birth and again at weaning. At lambing, ewes are given a mothering score of 1-5. One for a ewe who stays very close to lamb/s during the tagging process to five, a ewe who abandons her lamb/s. Ewes are also closely monitored for udder health at marking and post weaning.

PRIME LAMBS

As well as capacity to rear an excellent prime lamb, there is demand for Polwarth wool in a niche Italian market.

Vitale Barberis Canonico (VBC) is an Italian fabric mill established in 1663. For the last 350 years VBC have manufactured fine woollen fabrics for high end suit making.

Polwarth wool is sought after by VBC for its unique compression characteristics. VBC uses a percentage of Polwarth wool in their fabrics to decrease wrinkling.

In Australia, VBC sources wool based on the following four criteria:

- Non-mulesed flock
- 20.4 to 21.8 micron
- 40 NKT minimum
- 85-110mm

SIRE REFERENCE

FAIRVIEW 16097 (HENRY)

Henry is a long-bodied ram with good depth of barrel and well covered from head to toe with excellent belly wool. He has a beautiful, soft, broad muzzle showing great masculinity and a long white staple with a bold 60's count. He won Supreme Champion Polwarth at the Australian Sheep and Wool Show in July 2018 and Best Rams Head in 2018 and 2019. In 2021, 100 straws of Henry's semen were sold to Spain.



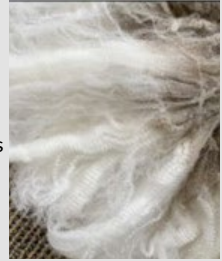
FAIRVIEW 17161 (MACK)

The Marcus bloodline stemmed back to Geoff Kemp and Homeleigh Polwarths at Heathcote in Victoria. The bloodline consistently threw tall upstanding sheep. Mack was a large framed well-balanced ram who stood squarely. He was an easy care plain bodied sire who was cleaner on the points and had a lovely soft broad muzzle with no pigmentation. His wool was soft, white and of good character. The combination of carcass and productive wool characteristics made Mack an excellent dual-purpose sire. In 2022, 100 straws of Mack's semen were sold to the United Kingdom.



FAIRVIEW 19120 (WHITE 72)

Fairview 19120 is a grandson of another successful Mt Alma bloodline. He is a structurally correct medium size ram with a thick well-muscled hindquarter which has carried through to his offspring. His 60'S type wool is very soft and white with a well-defined crimp.



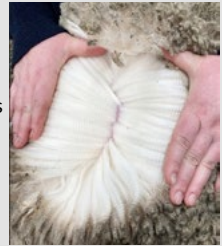
FAIRVIEW 20202 (PINK 20)

The sire of Pink 20 was purchased directly from the Rendlesham stud (Tasmania) in January 2019. Pink 20 is a medium sized ram with good head coverage. He has soft fine wool with a great length of staple. As a hogget, Pink 20's wool test results were 21.1 micron, 3 SD, 14.1 FDCV and 99.8 CF.



FAIRVIEW 20042 (ORANGE 25)

Orange 25 is a son of Mt Alma Orange 3278 who was potentially the most successful Polwarth sire in recent years. Born in 2010, Orange 3278 was a large upstanding correct sire. He was sold internationally to South America where he had widespread impact in flocks. Orange 25 has a white dense fleece with bold well-defined crimp. He won Champion Polwarth Fleece at the 2023 Australian Sheep and Wool Show.



FAIRVIEW 20018 (ORANGE 72)

Orange 72 was another son of Mt Alma Orange 3278. Orange 72 had high yielding soft white wool with a long staple. He was very pure in the face with great depth of carcass and well-defined hindquarter.
